

to the health and safety of her patients. We do not believe that a set of lesser sanctions, such as those recommended by the Review Committee, would be sufficient to safeguard the public and to uphold the integrity of AMCB certification. Consequently, the Board determines that the appropriate sanction is to revoke Respondent's certification.

The revocation sanction herein imposed shall become effective immediately.

A right of administrative appeal from this Final Decision exists pursuant to Section II.H. of the AMCB Disciplinary Policies and Procedures, a copy of which is being provided herewith.
